Information and Advice

We are Scotland's independent scrutiny body on environmental law. It is our responsibility to scrutinise the effectiveness of environmental law in Scotland and how it is implemented and applied. We also look at whether public bodies in Scotland are compliant with their responsibilities regarding environmental law.

We fulfil our responsibilities through our <u>monitoring and analysis</u> work and by undertaking <u>investigative</u> work. You can read more information about <u>what we can investigate</u> on our website.

We often receive complaints about damage to the environment, for example sewage discharges or drinking water contamination. It is important to note that other regulatory bodies exist to deal with these types of concerns, such as the Scottish Environment Protection Agency. Local Authorities also have responsibilities in respect of concerns about environmental health and contaminated land.

To assist you we have put together a basic guide listing key organisations. Please note this list is not exhaustive and is not intended as a detailed breakdown of legal duties.
