As you have not directly raised this issue yet with the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA), who are the principal regulator with a role in this area, I consider that your representation to ESS is premature. In short, it is not possible at this stage to determine if there has been a failure on the part of SEPA to comply with environmental law, whether the law itself is effective, or if it has been implemented / applied effectively.
