Information request – excessive cost – ESS.IR.023

Thank you for your email of 2 December 2025, requesting information under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA). The information you requested is as follows:

All correspondence (since 1 January 2024) sent to, and received from the:

- Deputy Director of the Future Environment Division, Scottish Government
- Future Environment Division, Scottish Government
- Director of Environment and Forestry, Scottish Government
- Sponsorship Hub, Scottish Government

While our aim is to provide information whenever possible, in this instance the costs of locating, retrieving and providing the information requested would exceed the upper cost limit of £600, as set out in section 12 of FOISA.

The reason for this is the significant volume of documents which would require to be located, retrieved and appropriately redacted. Public authorities are not required to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying would exceed this upper cost limit.

Options for reducing the cost

You may wish to consider reducing the scope of your request in order that the costs can be brought below £600. For example, you could restrict your request to a specific piece of work carried out by ESS, as this would allow us to limit the searches that would require to be conducted. Right to seek a review


If you are unhappy with this response to your request under FOISA you may ask us to carry out an internal review of the response by writing to:

Your review request should explain why you are dissatisfied with this response, and should be made within 40 working days from the date when you received this letter. We will complete the review and tell you the result within 20 working days from the date when we receive your review request.
